OVER 35 MASTERS AUSTRALIAN ASIAN ASSOCIATION CUP FINAL

The Winner of Group A and the Winner of Group B will play in the Final for the **Australian Asian Association Cup** on Nov 27. Should the scores be tied after the 60 min regulation time, extra time of 10 min halves will be played.

SENIORS LEAGUE COMPETITION FINAL

After the Eliminary stages, the 2 top teams from Groups A, B, C and D will qualify to compete in the knockout stages as stated in the fixtures. Should the scores be tied after the regulation time, extra time of 10 min halves will be played.

PENALTIES : Seniors, Masters and Juniors

Should extra-time not determine a winner in any of the finals, a penalty shoot will ensue. The penalty shoot-out will consist of five (5) penalties per team. The team with the highest score after each team has taken its allocated five penalties will be deemed the winner. Should the teams still be deadlocked after the regulation 5 penalties, then a winner will be determined by the "sudden death" rule (ie. the team that scores first wins).
